He is being held by the little girl, Tendai. Tendai in the Shona language means “to be thankful”. Mike’s teen-age mother died on the streets of Harare but now Mike has a loving home at Makumbi.

In 2009 Zimbabwe Run funds were spent on:

- The building of a dormitory for the older boys.
- Food, clothes and school fees for 100 orphans.

In 2010 Zimbabwe funds will be spent on:

- A 60KvA electric generator since the orphanage is experiencing frequent power outages and there is little wood for fuel.
- A small green house to boost garden production.
- Food, clothes and school fees for 100 orphans.
